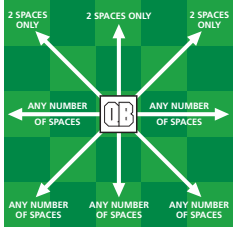
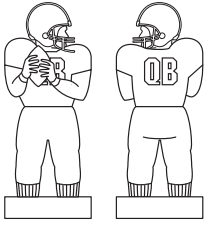


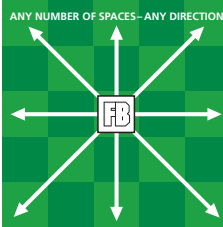
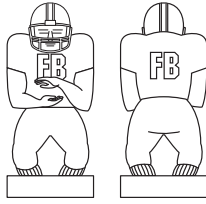
Pieces, Positions and Moves

OFFENSE



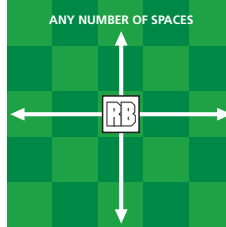
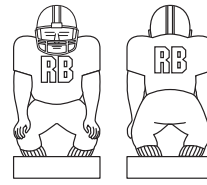
Quarterback (QB)

The quarterback may move straight forward or diagonally forward not more than two spaces, or horizontally, straight backward or diagonally backward any number of spaces, if not impeded by another piece. The quarterback may only capture a piece inside the opponent's ten-yard line.



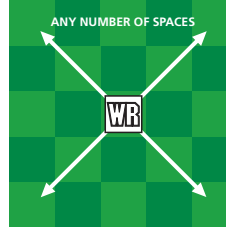
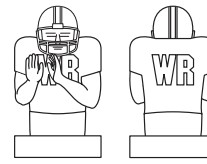
Fullback (FB)

The fullback may move any number of spaces horizontally, vertically or diagonally, if not impeded by another piece.



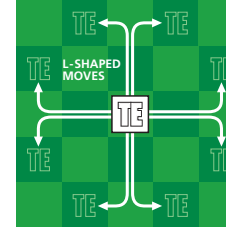
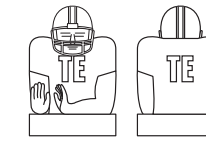
Running Back (RB)

The running back may move any number of spaces horizontally or vertically, if not impeded by another piece.



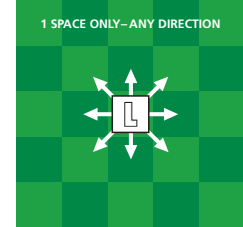
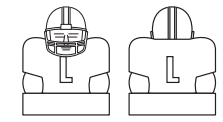
Wide Receiver (WR)

The two wide receivers may move any number of spaces diagonally, if not impeded by another piece. They must stay on opposite color squares.



Tight End (TE)

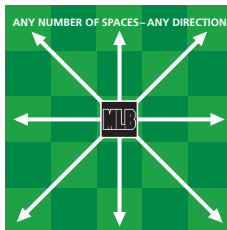
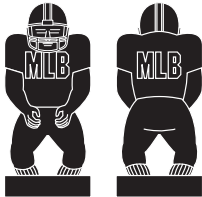
The tight end moves in an L-shape manner: 2-1 vertical/horizontal or 2-1 horizontal/vertical, and is the only offensive piece that may jump over other pieces.



Linemen (L)

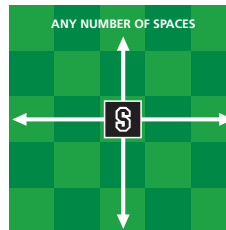
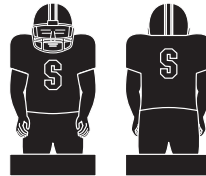
The five offensive linemen may move individually one space in any direction, and may capture pieces with a forward, backward, or diagonal move.

DEFENSE



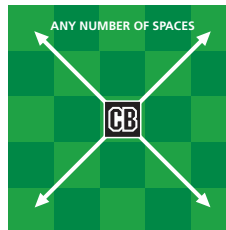
Middle Linebacker (MLB)

The middle linebacker is the most valuable defensive piece. It may move any number of spaces horizontally, vertically, or diagonally if not impeded by another piece.



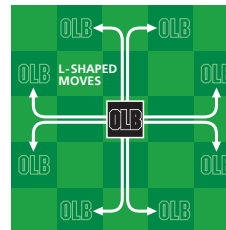
Safeties (S)

The two safeties may move any number of spaces vertically or horizontally if not impeded by another piece.



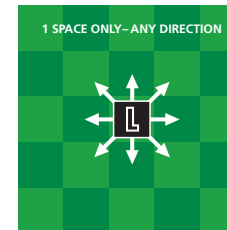
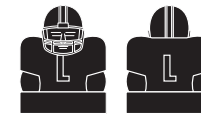
Cornerbacks (CB)

The two cornerbacks may move any number of spaces diagonally, if not impeded by another piece. They must stay on opposite color squares.



Outside Linebackers (OLB)

The two outside linebackers move in an L-shape manner: 2-1 vertical/horizontal or 2-1 horizontal/vertical, and are the only defensive pieces that may jump over other pieces.



Linemen (L)

The four defensive linemen may move individually one space in any direction, and may capture pieces with a forward, backward, or diagonal move.
